INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

For Admission into M.E (Mining Engineering) Self-Finance Program for the academic year 2018-2019

General Information

- 1. M.E (Mining Engineering) is a Two-Year (4 Semesters) Self-Financed Program with an initial intake of 18, offered at the University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad, Telangana for 2018-2019. The semester tuition fee is Rs 25,000/- and one time Autonomous Fee of Rs 9770/- . No hostel accommodation will be provided.
- 2. For admission into M.E (Mining Engineering) Self-Financed Program at University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad, first preference will be given to GATE qualified candidates. However, GATE qualified candidates are not eligible for AICTE Scholarship.
- 3. For candidates not qualified in GATE in Mining Engineering, University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad, is conducting an Entrance Test for admission into M.E (Mining Engineering) Self-Finance Program on Tuesday, 28th August 2018 at University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad 500007.
- 4. After exhausting GATE qualified candidates, the remaining vacant seats will be filled with those candidates who have secured ranks in the Entrance Test for M.E (Mining Engineering) as per Merit Order.
- 5. Candidates shall fulfill the eligibility criteria laid down in the relevant GOs at the time of admissions.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
- 2. The candidate should satisfy the local/non-local status requirements as laid down in the regulations of admission. (Ref. G.OMs.No.153 dated 22-08-2007)
- 3. As per AICTE the eligibility criterion for admission to Engineering is 50% in the qualifying examination (45% for reserved category). Further, the qualifying degree (Professional courses) obtained under distance mode must have AICTE/ Distance Education Council (DEC) approval.

Application Procedure

1. Candidates are required to apply for **Entrance Test in ME (Mining Engineering)** who have not qualified in GATE in Mining Engineering as per **Annexure-I**

- 2. Candidates who have qualified in **GATE in Mining Engineering** are also required to apply for admission into ME (Mining Engineering) as per **Annexure-II**
- 3. i) The application form duly filled in, should reach the Principal, University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad 500 007 (T.S) in person or by post, on or before 14.08.2018 (Tuesday), 5.00 pm..
 - ii) Last date for submission of Application Form with Late fee (in person only) is 18.08.2018 (Saturday) 5.00.P.M. at the Principal's Office, University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad-500007.
- 4. Fee Details

Each application must be accompanied by Application Fee in the form of DD drawn in favour of "PRINCIPAL, UCE, OU" payable at Hyderabad as per the following table.

- 5. The Entrance Test will be conducted on Tuesday, 28.August 2018 from 11.00 AM to 1.00 PM at University College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad 500007, for candidates not qualified in GATE in Mining Engineering. It will be of two hour duration with 120 multiple choice objective type questions (10 questions from Engineering Mathematics and 110 questions from Mining Engineering), carrying one mark for each question. No negative marks will be awarded for incorrect answer. The minimum qualifying mark in the Entrance Test is 30. In case of SC/ST there is no minimum qualifying marks.
- **6.** The Question Papers will be in English only. The Entrance test syllabus in Mining Engineering is given in **Annexure-A**
- 7. The Hall-Tickets should be collected in person from 24-08-2018 to 27-08-2018 at the Principal Office, College of Engineering, Osmania University, Hyderabad. Without Hall-Tickets the candidate will not be allowed into the test centre.
- 8. Appearing in the entrance test does not guarantee admission. The candidate has to satisfy all the requirements at the time of admission.
